### Why prepare for re-use?





# System for preparing for re-use

- All the city's recycling stations accept items for reuse
  - 3 large recycling stations
  - 2 medium recyling stations
  - 8 mini recycling stastons
- The items are then distributed to a new owner throught different channels

#### Channels of distribution

- Mini recyling stations
  - citizens can pick up what others have submitted from the same shelves (free)





#### Channels of distribution

- Medium recycling stations
  - Organizations and businesses can collect re-use items by agreement for free (reuse partners)
  - Some re-use items are transported to the larger stations and sold there
  - Items of little value is placed in shelves at the station and offered citizens for free





#### Channels of distribution


- Large recycling stations
  - Organizations and businesses can collect re-use items by agreement for free (reuse partners)
  - Wood pallets are sold to partners who redistribute them
  - Building materials are offered citizens for free on-site
  - The rest of the re-use items are sold at the stations





#### How to become a partner


- Organizations and businesses can apply once a year
- Must have a plan for how to get the reuse items back in use
- Beneficial to society are prioritized
- Have to report weight
- For textile, white goods and wood pallets other rules apply





#### Digital calender for partners

- Approximately 20 different re-use partners
- Assigned collection time in the calender at the different stations



### Numbers




#### Tonnage
